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## Determining precise birth time of Lord Sri Rama

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#### Abstract

Sage Valmiki in his epic Ramayana has stated that five planets were in exaltation in Lord Sri Rama's birth chart, but he did not mention the precise birth time. We have calculated avastha due to Moon as explained in Brihat Parasara Hora Sastra and Sage Valmiki's description of Lord Rama's birth chart, then compared them with Lord Rama's characteristics mentioned in Ramayana to determine precise birth time of Lord Sri Rama.

Keywords: Astrology, Rama, moon, avasthas of planets, prakasavastha

#### Introduction

Sage Valmiki in his Sri Ramayana explained planetary positions in the birth chart of Lord Sri Rama. Many in the past have explored the possibilities of the position of planet Jupiter in the birth chart of Lord Sri Rama in different ways. Stephen Knapp<sup>[1]</sup> refers to Pushkar Bhatnagar's book Dating the Era of Lord Rama and thinks that 10th January 5114 BCE was Lord Rama's birth date and 12:30pm could be his birth time without any further explanation. An article <sup>[2]</sup> mentioned that, based on a planetarium software and from other theory of Pushkar Bhatnagar, Lord Sri Rama's birth date and time could have been 10<sup>th</sup> January 5114 BC and at 12:30 pm without any explanation on how the birth time was calculated. Arjan Dhanak <sup>[3]</sup> has mentioned that Lord Sri Rama was born at 12.30 p.m. on 10th January 5114 BC, which also refers to the works of Pushkar Bhatnagar. Jwala Narasimha Rao<sup>[4]</sup>, also referred to Pushkar Bhatnagar's works on Lord Rama and opines that Lord Sri Ram was born on the noon of January 10, 5114 BC (7123 years back) with no details on how birth time was calculated. Akkinapragada et al, <sup>[5]</sup> reported Sun's precise position in Lord Rama's birth chart based on tithi and angle between Sun and Moon in Chaitra month (from Padyami tithi start to Asthami tithi end) and further mentioned position of Jupiter in Cancer based on Sage Valmiki's Ramayana. Anik Charan [6] had mentioned that Lord Sri Rama was born 9114 years before around noon but did not provide any methodology based on which this was determined. Akash <sup>[7]</sup> mentioned that Lord Rama was born on 10 January 5114 BCE (about 7129 years ago) but has not mentioned birth time. Akkinapragada et al, [8] reported precise position of Venus by comparing Malavya yoga features mentioned in Brihat Parasara Hora Sastra with Lord Rama's characteristics as detailed by Sage Valmiki in his Ramayana. An article [9] mentioned that Lord Sri Rama was born on 10 January 5115 BC at 12:14:31 but didn't provide further details on precise calculation of the birth time. Kshitij Sharma<sup>[10]</sup> had mentioned about possible planetary positions in the birth chart of Lord Sri Rama but did not provide the specific birth time. Akkinapragada et al, <sup>[11]</sup> reported precise position of Jupiter by comparing Hamsa (Hansa) yoga's features mentioned in Brihat Parasara Hora Sastra with Lord Rama's characteristics as detailed by Sage Valmiki in his Ramayana. Renay Oshop <sup>[12]</sup>, who is an astrologer herself, tried to compare Sita's horoscope with Lord Rama's but it was not clear about the source of Sita's horoscope. Nandita Pandey <sup>[13]</sup> reported, Jupiter, Saturn, Mars, Sun, Venus, Rahu and Ketu all in their exalted state along with Mercury in Lord Sri Rama's birth chart but did not mention the birth time. Prof. Desikam [14] referred to Thunchath Ezhuthachan's Ramayana and thinks Mars was in Makaram (Capricorn) but didn't give any further details on precise position of Mars with no further details on Lord Sri Rama's birth time. Akkinapragada et al, <sup>[15]</sup> reported precise position of Saturn by comparing Sasa yoga's features mentioned in Brihat Parasara Hora Sastra with Lord Rama's characteristics as detailed by Sage Valmiki in his Ramayana.

Sureshwara <sup>[16]</sup> reported that, Mars was exalted in Capricorn at 280 but was not backed up by any calculations and also mentioned that Jupiter was in conjunction with Moon. Another astrologer <sup>[17]</sup> had discussed about various planetary positions in Lord Sri Rama's birth chart but did not mention about his birth time. Akkinapragada et al, [18] gave a detailed explanation about Mercury's absence in Lord Rama's birth chart which further enhances the mysteries surrounding Lord Sri Rama's birth chart. Gaurav Dave <sup>[19]</sup> has discussed about various planets and their placements in Lord Sri Rama's birth chart but did not mention about his birth time. Akkinapragada et al, <sup>[20]</sup> reported precise position of Mars by comparing Ruchaka yoga's features mentioned in Brihat Parasara Hora Sastra with Lord Sri Rama's characteristics as detailed by Sage Valmiki in his Ramayana. Author of article [21] tried to explain various aspects of Lord Sri Rama's birth chart but did not provide any clarification on the birth time of Lord Sri Rama. Akkinapragada et al, <sup>[22]</sup> reported precise position of Moon in Lord Sri Rama's birth chart, by comparing Effects of first house from Brihat Samhita Hora Sastra slokas with Lord Sri Rama's characteristics as detailed in Sage Valmiki's Ramayana.

Based on above references and their conclusions, below questions were drawn:

1. What could be the precise birth time of Lord Rama?

In this research paper, we will explore various aspects to find an answer to the above question.

### **Method and Materials**

Now the question is, what Sage Valmiki mentioned about birth time of Lord Sri Rama? With reference to Vālmiki Rāmāyana (Bala Kanda.18/ Slokas 8, 9)<sup>[23]</sup>, five planets were in exaltation in Lord Sri Rama's birth chart. Akkinapragada *et al*, <sup>[5, 8, 11, 15, 20, 22]</sup> reported Sun's, Venus's, Jupiter's, Saturn's, Mars's and Moon's precise positions in their exalted states. Akkinapragada *et al*, <sup>[18]</sup> ruled out the existence of planet Mercury (Budha) in Lord Rama's birth chart. This research considers these planetary positions and characteristics of Lord Sri Rama mentioned in Sage Valmiki's Ramayana and proceeds further to ascertain the birth time of Lord Sri Rama.

As per sloka in Fig-1, Lord Rama was born on 9<sup>th</sup> tithi of Chaitra month, in Karkata (Cancer) lagna, where Moon was in its own house (Karkata) along with Jupiter and the nakshatra's lord being Adithi. Since the lord for Punarvasu is Adithi, we conclude that Moon is placed in the 4<sup>th</sup> pada of Punarvasu within 3.3<sup>0</sup> of Cancer. Moving forward, let us examine the 1<sup>st</sup> line of second sloka in Fig-1. "taileatitking tierty" (excerpt from Fig-1) tet+3eet+titking, tet = Own, self, individual, 3eet = exalted or highest, titking = contained in their positions, tiety = collection of five, refers to 5 planets are in their own exaltation positions.

As per Brihat Parasara Hora Sastra <sup>[24]</sup>, chapter 45, Page 460, "Avasthas of Planets", slokas 52-63 mentions 12 different Avasthas based on a planet:




Fig 2: Brihat Parasara Hora Sastra <sup>[24]</sup>, chapter 45, sloka 52




Fig 4: Brihat Parasara Hora Sastra <sup>[24]</sup>, chapter 45, sloka 54




Fig 8: Brihat Parasara Hora Sastra <sup>[24]</sup>, chapter 45, sloka 58

As per Sage Valmiki's Ramayana <sup>[23]</sup> Fig-14, we see that, the meaning of प्रोद्यमाने = when raising - when ascendent; [Abhijit lagna = advancing daytime]. Based on this, we calculated the midday time for the past 10 years (2014-2023) sunrise, sunset times for Ram Navami, Varanasi, India location and this data was used to further calculate 'Ghatis (g)' to determine Lord Sri Rama's precise birth time. Details are in below Table-2:

#### **Results and Discussions**

• With reference to Table-1 and Table-2, we need to determine, which Avastha did Lord Sri Rama had, based

on below factors and formula given in Chapter 45<sup>[24]</sup>, Page 454, slokas 30-37.

Avastha = remainder of 
$$\left[\frac{(s*p*n)+(a+g+r)}{12}\right]$$

Where, the logic to determine values for s, p, n, a, g, r are given in below Table-3:

By substituting the derived values from Table-3 into Equation-1, we get the remainder as: 4.6625. As the avastha value (remainder) 4.6625 falls within the scale of 4-5, we can determine that Lord Sri Rama had Prakashavastha, which as per Table-1 (Fig-5), explains that "native will be famous in the world, will have his virtues exposed through royal patronage, be surrounded by horses, elephants, females and ornaments, and will visit shrines". This perfectly matches with the description given by Sage Valmiki in Ramayana about Lord Sri Rama, see Table-4.

#### Conclusion

# Based on above given methods and materials, results and discussions

- 1. As per Table-2, the average Ghatis for last 10 years is 15.66.
- 2. When these Ghatis 15.66 were substituted into Equation-1, we get the avastha as Prakashavastha, and the qualities of Prakashavastha are perfectly matching with Lord Sri Rama's characteristics as explained in Table-4. With this we can safely conclude that Ghatis 15.66 is correct.
- 3. 15.66 Ghatis = 15.66 \* 24 minutes = 375.84 minutes (where 1 Ghati = 24 minutes).
- 4. 375.84 minutes = 6 hours 15 minutes and 50 seconds.
- 5. From Table-2, we find that in year 2016, the time of Sunrise was at the least at 5:36:00. To this we add 6:15:50, which is 11:51:50 am.
- 6. Similarly, from Table-2, we find that in year 2018, the time of Sunrise was at the maximum at 5:57:00. To this we add 6:15:50, which is 12:12:50 pm.
- 7. Since we do not know the 'precise year' in which Lord Sri Rama was 'born', we calculated Lord Sri Rama's time of birth by adding Ghatis to the Ram Navami's sunrise time. Based on minimum time of Sunrise 5:36:00

the time of birth is 11:51: 50 AM and maximum time of Sunrise 5:57:00 the time of birth is 12:12:50 PM.

8. Based on these, we can safely assume that, Lord Sri Rama's time of birth should be anywhere between 11:51:50 am to 12:12:50 pm on Navami Tithi of Chaitra month (Fig-1).
