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Lakshmana's time of birth and reason for going into exile with Lord Sri Rama, based on his birth and astro transit charts

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Abstract

In this research paper, we have found out (1) Lakshmana's lagna position (angle in degrees) and time of birth (2) Lakshmana's astro transit chart at the time of his wedding along with dasa and its effects (3) Reasons for Lakshmana going to exile along with his elder brother Lord Sri Rama, based on his birth and astro transit charts (4) Effects of various mahadasas, antardasas, pratyantardasas and sookshmantardasas on Lakshmana during these events. With the help of Brihat Parashara Hora Shastra and Sage Valmiki's Ramayana we have drawn several conclusions regarding Lakshmana's life events.

Keywords: Lord Sri Rama, Lakshmana, Ayodhya, wedding, exile

Introduction

Sage Valmiki in his epic Ramayana explained planetary positions in the birth chart of Lord Shri Ram but precise positions of those planets were not given.

Akkinapragada *et al* ^[1, 2] reported Sun's precise position in Lord Shri Ram's birth chart based on tithi and angle between Sun and Moon in Chaitra month (from Padyami tithi start to Asthami tithi end) and further corroborated it with Dasa 'Varga Classifications' and Descriptions.

Akkinapragada *et al* ^[3, 4] reported precise position of Moon in Lord Shri Ram's birth chart, by comparing Effects of first house from Brihat Samhita Hora Sastra slokas with Lord Shri Ram's characteristics as detailed in Sage Valmiki's Ramayana and further corroborated it with Dasa 'Varga Classifications' and Descriptions.

Akkinapragada *et al* ^[5, 6] reported precise position of Mars by comparing Ruchaka yoga's features mentioned in Brihat Parasara Hora Sastra with Lord Shri Ram's characteristics as detailed in Sage Valmiki's Ramayana and further corroborated it with Dasa 'Varga Classifications' and Descriptions.

Akkinapragada *et al* ^[7, 8] reported precise position of Jupiter by comparing Hamsa (Hansa) yoga's features mentioned in Brihat Parasara Hora Sastra with Lord Shri Ram's characteristics as detailed by Sage Valmiki in his Ramayana and further corroborated it with Dasa 'Varga Classifications' and Descriptions.

Akkinapragada *et al* ^[9, 10] reported precise position of Venus by comparing Malavya yoga features mentioned in Brihat Parasara Hora Sastra with Lord Shri Ram's characteristics as detailed by Sage Valmiki in his Ramayana and further corroborated it with Dasa 'Varga Classifications' and Descriptions.

Akkinapragada *et al* ^[11, 12] reported precise position of Saturn by comparing Sasa yoga's features mentioned in Brihat Parasara Hora Sastra with Lord Shri Ram's characteristics as detailed by Sage Valmiki in his Ramayana and further corroborated it with Dasa 'Varga Classifications' and Descriptions.

Akkinapragada *et al* ^[13] reported precise birth time of Lord Shri Ram based on Prakasavastha mentioned in Brihat Parasara Hora Sastra.

Akkinapragada *et al* ^[14, 15] gave a detailed explanation about Mercury's absence in Lord Shri Ram's birth chart.

Akkinapragada *et al* ^[16] gave a detailed explanation about placement of Rahu and Ketu in Lord Sri Ram's birth chart.

Akkinapragada *et al* ^[17] has discussed about effects of Jupiter mahadasa on Lord Sri Rama.

Akkinapragada *et al* ^[18] has discussed about effects of Saturn, Ketu, Venus antardasas in Saturn mahadasa on Lord Sri Rama and also explored unknown facts of Lord Sri Rama's childhood.

Akkinapragada *et al* ^[19] has discussed about effects of Sun's antardasa in Saturn mahadasa on Lord Sri Rama and also explored various facts of Lord Sri Rama's childhood.

Akkinapragada *et al* ^[20] has discussed about effects of Moon's pratyantardasa in Moon's antardasa in Saturn mahadasa of Lord Sri Rama and also explored planetary combinations that have led to Lord Sri Rama breaking the bow and his wedding with Sita Devi.

Akkinapragada *et al* ^[21] has discussed the deadly planetary combination which led to Lord Sri Rama's encounter with Bhaargava Rama.

Akkinapragada *et al* ^[22] has discussed whether exalted Mars and Jupiter in Lord Sri Rama's planetary transit influenced King Dasaratha to coronate him as prince of Ayodhya.

Akkinapragada *et al* ^[23] has discussed about dreadful planetary placements paired with Sade Sati which forced Lord Sri Rama to go into exile.

Akkinapragada *et al* ^[24] has discussed about planetary combinations that led to King Dasaratha's death based on Lord Sri Rama's astro transit chart.

Akkinapragada *et al* ^[25] has discussed about maraka planets that were responsible for King Dasaratha's death based on his four sons astro transit charts.

Akkinapragada *et al* ^[26] has discussed Bharatha's time of birth and lagna degrees, astro transit chart for his wedding and transfer of power from Lord Sri Rama.

In this research paper, we would like to explore (1) Lakshmana's lagna position (angle in degrees) and time of birth (2) Lakshmana's astro transit chart at the time of his wedding along with dasa and its effects (3) Reasons for Lakshmana going to exile along with his elder brother Lord Sri Rama (4) Effects of various mahadasas, antardasas, pratyantardasas and sookshmantardasas on Lakshmana during these events.

Method and Materials

In Valmiki Ramayana, Bala Kanda ^[25], Sarga 18, Sloka 15 is as given below in Fig-1:

**पुष्ये जातस्तु भरतो मीनलगने प्रसन्नधीः ।
सार्पे जातौ तु सौमित्री कुब्जिरेऽभ्युदिते रवौ ॥ १-१८-१५**

The meaning of slokas in Fig-1 are as follows: "With the dawn of sun on the next day, fair-minded Bharata is born under Pisces where puSyami is the star of day, later the sons of Sumitra, namely Lakshmana and Shatrughna are born under Cancer, where aashleSa is the star of the day, i.e., the tenth of chaitra month".

Since, Lord Sri Rama was born in Abhijit lagna between 11:51:50 am to 12:12:50 pm as per Akkinapragada *et al* ^[13], and Lakshmana was born next day around mid-day, we conclude that the time difference between the birth of Lord Sri Rama and Lakshmana was about 24 hours (or 1 day) – as per Akkinapragada *et al* ^[25].

Lakshmana was born in Aslesha star on Shukla Paksha Dashami of Chaitra Month. We calculated the lagna based on the Aslesha star for last 10 years on Shukla Paksha Dashami in Chaitra Month, Aslesha Star at Ayodhya from 2014-2023 and found the average Lagna (3rd column) as 16.81°. So our

explanation given under Fig-1 that Lakshmana was born around 24 hours later Lord Sri Rama was born is feasible because, Lord Sri Rama was born between 11:51:50 am to 12:12:50 pm as per Akkinapragada *et al* ^[13] in the month of Chaitra on Shukla Paksha Navami.

At the time of Lakshmana's birth, Moon was in Cancer at 16.8125⁰ (Fig-2) along with Jupiter. In Brihat Parasara Hora Sastra [29], Chapter 46 ("Dasas [Periods] of Planets") on page 508 (see Fig-6), the following Sloka 16 is given.

दशमानं मयातघ्नं भभोगेन हृतं फलम् ।
दशया भुक्तवर्षाद्यं भोग्यं मानाद् विशोधितम् ॥१६॥

As per sloka in Fig-6, "To find out the remainder of the Dasa operating at the time of birth, first find out the expired portion of the Dasa of the concerned planet. This is done as follows: Multiply the Dasa period of the planet concerned by the period of stay of the Moon in the janma nakshatra that has expired and divide it by the total period of the stay of the Moon in that nakshatra. The figure in years, months etc, so arrived at will be the expired period of the Dasa. If this figure

is deducted from the total period of the Dasa, we will get the balance of Dasa at the time of birth".

With reference to Fig-1, Fig-2 and Fig-6, Lakshmana was born towards the end of Sun (Sun) mahadasha. As per Brihat Parasara Hora Sastra [29], Chapter 46 ("Dasas [Periods] of Planets") on page 507, slokas 12-14, average age of a human being is considered as 120 years and as per sloka 15, total tenure of Sun's mahadasha is 6 years along with other planet's mahadashas outlined there.

Our previous research works [14, 15], discussed that planet Mercury was 'not in existence' during Ramayana Period. This means, we need to takeaway 17 years of Mercury from 120 years, and proportionately scale up and distribute other planets mahadasha tenures (as Mercury [14, 15] was non-existent and it's 17 years tenure cannot be considered for Lakshmana).

Based on this, Sun's mahadasha tenure instead of 7 years now becomes 6 years for Lakshmana (likewise, remaining planets mahadasha tenures are also calculated - see Table-1).

Table 2: With reference to Fig-6, planets mahadasha tenures were proportionately scaled (due to Mercury's [14, 15] absence during Ramayana period)

Since, planet Mercury [14, 15] is absent during Ramayana period, the houses Gemini and Virgo are lorded by Moon and Sun respectively. As per Mahadasas, Sun dasa comes before the Moon dasa. Therefore, the Mercury (Budha) dasa is taken by Sun and Moon respectively in the ratio of their actual dasa tenures. As per Table-2, Sun's dasa period is 7 years and Moon's dasa period is 11.65 years, taking these into consideration, the total period = 7 years + 11.65 years = 18.65 which corresponds to 17 years of Mercury (Budha) dasa.

The extrapolated Sun's dasa is 7 years (see Table-2), but the Sun's dasa is only 6 years with Budha being present. Since Budha is not present during Ramayana time period, the extra

1 year in Sun's dasa is transferred to Aslesha star. So, as Lakshmana was born into the Aslesha 1st pada, it is to be noted that, he was only left with 1 year of Sun's mahadasha after his birth.

According to Akkinapragada *et al* [20], Lord Sri Rama's age at the time of his wedding was 12 years 0 months and 4 days. As Lakshmana's wedding happened along with Lord Sri Rama's as per Valmiki Ramayana [28], Bala Kanda, Sargas 72, Sloka 11, Lakshmana's age must be 12 years 0 months and 3 days (as he was born 1 day later Lord Sri Rama, see Fig-1 and subsequent explanation below it).

As remainder of Sun's mahadasa after his birth based on above calculation was just 1 year and when added to Moon's mahadasa's 11.65 years his age was 12 years 7 months and 24 days, which means he must had got wedded in Moon's

mahadasa. We now need to find, during which antardasa Lakshmana was under during his wedding event. Calculations are shown in below Table-3.

From Table-3, we know that it was under Sun's antardasa in Moon's mahadasa, Lakshmana got wedded (as his age at wedding was 12 years 0 months 3 days). We now need to find

under which pratyantardasa Lakshmana was under during his wedding event. See Table-4 for calculations.

From Table-4, we know that Lakshmana was under Sun's pratyantardasa in Sun's antardasa in Moon's mahadasa when he got wedded at the age of 12 years 0 months and 3 days. From Akkinapragada *et al* [23], we know that, Lord Sri Rama's age was 24 years 0 months and 25 days (= 8663.742 days) when King Dasaratha first thought of coronating Lord Sri Rama as prince of Ayodhya. We know from above discussion that, Lakshmana had 1 year of Sun's mahadasa remaining after his birth, followed by 11.65 years of Moon's mahadasa

and 8.15 years of Mars's mahadasas respectively, by the end of which, Lakshmana's age should be 20.8 years. The next mahadasa for Lakshmana after Mars is 20.97 years of Rahu mahadasa. So it must be during Rahu's mahadasa, Lakshmana must have gone into exile along with Lord Sri Rama and Sita Devi. So we need to precisely find out during which antardasa, pratyantardasa and sookshmantardasa was Lakshmana under during the exile period. See Table-5 below for antardasas in Rahu mahadasa.

From Table-5, we know that it was in Rahu's antardasa in Rahu's mahadasa Lakshmana went into exile, now we need to

find out under which pratyantardasa was Lakshmana in during this event. See Table-6 below for pratyantardasa calculations.

From Table-6, we know that it was in Moon's pratyantardasa in Rahu's antardasa in Rahu's mahadasa Lakshmana went into exile, now we need to find out under which

sookshmantardasa was Lakshmana in during this event. See Table-7 below for sookshmantardasa calculations.

From Table-7, we know that, Lakshmana was under Jupiter's sookshmantardasa in Moon's pratyantardasa in Rahu's antardasa in Rahu's mahadasa when he went into exile along with Lord Sri Rama and Sita Devi.

In Brihat Parasara Hora Sastra ^[27], Chapter 53 "Effects of the Antardasa of the Sun in the Dasa of Moon" on Page 649, the following slokas 65-67 are given (see Fig-7):

The meaning of slokas in Fig-7 is as follows: "Recovery of the lost kingdom (high position in government) and wealth, happiness in the family, acquisition of villages and land with the kind assistance of the friends and the king (government), birth of a son, beneficence of Goddess Lakshmi, will be the beneficial results in the Antardasa of the Sun in the Dasa of the Moon, if the Sun be in his sign of exaltation, in his own sign, in kendra or the 5th, the 9th, the 11th, the 2nd or the 3rd. At the end of the Antardasa, there is likelihood of attacks of fever and lethargy".

In Brihat Parasara Hora Sastra ^[27], Chapter 61 "Effects of the Pratyantar Dasas in the Antardasa of planets" on Page 744, the following sloka 2 is given (see Fig-8):

The meaning of sloka in Fig-8 is as follows: "Various auspicious effects are produced if Sun be in trikona, angle or in exaltation, be the lord of an auspicious house, be in an auspicious house, and a benefic varga".

In Brihat Parasara Hora Sastra ^[27], Chapter 55 "Effects in the Antardasas of Rahu in the Dasa of Rahu" on Page 664, the following slokas 1-4 is given (see Fig-9):

The meaning of sloka in Fig-9 is as follows: "Effects like acquisition of a kingdom (attainment of a high position in government), enthusiasm, cordial relations with the king (government), happiness from wife and children and increase in property, will be derived in the Antardasa of Rahu in the Dasa of Rahu, if Rahu be in Cancer, Scorpio, Virgo or Sagittarius and be in the 3rd, the 6th, the 10th or the 11th from the Ascendant, or be associated with yogakaraka planet in his sign of exaltation".

In Brihat Parasara Hora Sastra ^[27], Chapter 61 "Effects of Pratyantar Dasas in the Antardasa of Rahu" on Page 754, the following sloka 36 is given (see Fig-10):

The meaning of sloka in Fig-10 is as follows: "Excitement, quarrels, worries, loss of reputation, fear, distress to father". In Brihat Parasara Hora Sastra ^[27], Chapter 62 "Effects of Sookshma Dasas in the pratyantardasa of Moon" on Page 772, the following sloka 14 is given (see Fig-11):

The meaning of sloka in Fig-11 is as follows: “Opulence and glory with Royal symbols, birth of Son, gain of property, enjoyments all around”. In Brihat Parasara Hora Sastra ^[29], Chapter 22 “Effects of The Eleventh House” on Page 183, the following sloka 2 is given (see Fig-12):

The meaning of sloka in Fig-12 is as follows: “Should the 11th lord be in the 11th itself, or be in an angle or trine from the ascendant, there will be many gains. Similarly if the 11th lord is exalted, though in combustion, there will be many gains”.

Results and Discussions

Similarly if the 11th lord is exalted, though in combustion, there will be many gains. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Effects of Fig-7’s applicability for Lakshmana: With reference to Fig-2, Lakshmana’s birth chart, Sun is in Aries, in his sign of exaltation. During the wedding, King Dasaratha gave lots of riches to all four brothers, and Lakshmana was one among them. Lakshmana gained wealth, had happiness in the family due to wedding, had beneficence of Goddess Lakshmi, again representing wealth. So the effects of Fig-6 compared to Lakshmana’s life events from Valmiki Ramayana are found to be true. • Effects of Fig-8’s applicability for Lakshmana: Mars is an auspicious planet for Cancer lagna native. As per Lakshmana’s birth chart Fig-2, he is a Cancer ascendant, so Mars is a benefic planet for him. As you can observe in his birth chart, Mars is placed in Capricorn and it has a 4th house powerful aspect on Aries, in which Sun is placed and exalted. Also, Sun being in Aries means it is in 10th house, which is one of the angular positions (1, 4, 7, 10) from the ascendant. Thus all the results mentioned in Fig-8 are applicable to Lakshmana. • Effects of Fig-9’s applicability for Lakshmana: This situations is when Lakshmana decided to go into exile with Lord Sri Rama along with Sita Devi. But as per Fig-9, Lakshmana was supposed to acquire a kingdom, must have had cordial relationship with King and happiness from wife and increase in property as Rahu was in Virgo as per his birth chart Fig-2 and Rahu was seen in Cancer as per Fig-4 – the day when Lakshmana went into exile. As you can see in Fig-4, Rahu is seen in Cancer along with Saturn and Lakshmana was undergoing 2nd phase of Sade Sati. So the auspicious results that Rahu were to be questioned. • Effects of Fig-10’s applicability for Lakshmana: As we know from Sage Valmiki’s Ramayana ^[28], Ayodhya Kanda, Sarga 23, Lakshmana argues with Lord Sri Rama to allow him to accompany him to forest for the exile period. The results mentioned in Fig-10 are aptly applicable to Lakshmana compared with Sage Valmiki’s Ramayana. • Effects of Fig-11’s applicability for Lakshmana: Jupiter’s sookshmantardasa in pratyantardasa of Moon must have brought opulence, glory, gain of property and enjoyments all around for Lakshmana. We know from Sage Valmiki’s Ramayana that, Lakshmana gained glory and his opulence has come in the form of doing service to his elder brother Lord Sri Rama throughout the exile period. Because of the affliction of Saturn and Rahu on Moon being in the same house (Cancer, Fig-4) have negated the gain of property and enjoyments for Lakshmana. • Effect of 11th house (Fig-12) applicability for Lakshmana: 11th house in a birth chart represents elder siblings and in Lakshmana’s case it will be Lord Sri Rama and Bharatha. With reference to Lakshmana’s birth chart (see Fig-2), 11th house is Taurus and its lord is Venus, which is placed in Pisces, and Pisces is 9th house from the ascendant. As per Fig-12’s results, Lakshmana must have had many gains from his elder brother Lord Sri Rama and when we observe Lakshmana’s life events from Sage Valmiki’s Ramayana ^[28], Bala Kanda, Sarga

	<p>22, we know that, when Lakshmana travelled with his elder brother Lord Sri Rama to protect Sage Viswamitra's sacred and grand ritual, he too got the knowledge of various astras and sastras from the Sage along with his elder brother. Lakshmana who travelled with his elder brother Lord Sri Rama to Mithila got married because of his brother's valour, see Valmiki's Ramayana [28], Bala Kanda, Sarga 72. Further, Lakshmana travels with his elder brother Lord Sri Rama into exile as mentioned in Valmiki's Ramayana [28], Ayodhya Kanda, Sarga 31. Throughout their exile period, Lakshmana along his elder brother Lord Sri Rama visits many sacred Sages in their hermitages and performs sacred rituals and got their blessings and serves his elder brother Lord Sri Rama. By killing May daemons like Indrajit during their exile period, Lakshmana got lot of name and fame.</p>
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Conclusion

- With reference to Table-1, Lakshmana's ascendant degrees were found to be 16.81^0 and his birth time was around 12:13 pm. This shall be further asserted in our future research work.
- Auspicious effects of Lakshmana were marred by the affliction of Saturn and Rahu on Moon and Jupiter being in the same house, Cancer (see Fig-4).
- As per the Effects of Eleventh house (see Fig-11), from Lakshmana's birth chart Fig-2, we understand that, Lakshmana enjoyed lots of gains from his elder brother, Lord Sri Rama.
- Based on the results discussed in Table-8 and from all the above, we can safely conclude that life events described in Sage Valmiki's Ramayana are aptly matching with the effects of various Mahadasa, Antardasas, Pratyantaradasa, Sookshmantardasas for Lakshmana that we derived.

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
