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# Possibilities of Lord Sri Rama encountering daemon Viraadha and meeting several erudite sages in dandakaranya as revealed from his transit chart

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#### Abstract

In this research paper, we have calculated the astro transit planetary placements when Lord Sri Rama met noble and highly erudite sages like Sage Atri & Anasuya Devi, Sage Sharabhanga, and Sage Suteekshana. We have also found out the reasons why daemon Viraadha proved to be a difficult opponent to fight with and how gallant Lord Sri Rama won over him. With the help of Brihat Parashara Hora Shastra and Sage Valmiki's Ramayana, we have drawn several conclusions regarding these events.

## Introduction

Akkinapragada *et al* <sup>[1, 2]</sup> reported Sun's precise position in Lord Shri Ram's birth chart based on tithi and angle between Sun and Moon in Chaitra month (from Padyami tithi start to Asthami tithi end) and further corroborated it with Dasa 'Varga Classifications' and Descriptions.

Akkinapragada *et al* <sup>[3, 4]</sup> reported precise position of Moon in Lord Shri Ram's birth chart, by comparing Effects of first house from Brihat Samhita Hora Sastra slokas with Lord Shri Ram's characteristics as detailed in Sage Valmiki's Ramayana and further corroborated it with Dasa 'Varga Classifications' and Descriptions.

Akkinapragada *et al* <sup>[5, 6]</sup> reported precise position of Mars by comparing Ruchaka yoga's features mentioned in Brihat Parasara Hora Sastra with Lord Shri Ram's characteristics as detailed in Sage Valmiki's Ramayana and further corroborated it with Dasa 'Varga Classifications' and Descriptions.

Akkinapragada *et al* <sup>[7, 8]</sup> reported precise position of Jupiter by comparing Hamsa (Hansa) yoga's features mentioned in Brihat Parasara Hora Sastra with Lord Shri Ram's characteristics as detailed by Sage Valmiki in his Ramayana and further corroborated it with Dasa 'Varga Classifications' and Descriptions.

Akkinapragada *et al* <sup>[9, 10]</sup> reported precise position of Venus by comparing Malavya yoga features mentioned in Brihat Parasara Hora Sastra with Lord Shri Ram's characteristics as detailed by Sage Valmiki in his Ramayana and further corroborated it with Dasa 'Varga Classifications' and Descriptions.

Akkinapragada *et al* [11, 12] reported precise position of Saturn by comparing Sasa yoga's features mentioned in Brihat Parasara Hora Sastra with Lord Shri Ram's characteristics as detailed by Sage Valmiki in his Ramayana and further corroborated it with Dasa 'Varga Classifications' and Descriptions.

Akkinapragada *et al* <sup>[13]</sup> reported precise birth time of Lord Shri Ram based on Prakasavastha mentioned in Brihat Parasara Hora Sastra.

Akkinapragada *et al* [14, 15] gave a detailed explanation about Mercury's absence in Lord Shri Ram's birth chart.

Akkinapragada  $et~al~^{[16]}$  gave a detailed explanation about placement of Rahu and Ketu in Lord Shri Ram's birth chart.

Akkinapragada et al [17] has discussed about effects of Jupiter mahadasa on Lord Sri Rama.

Akkinapragada *et al* <sup>[20]</sup> has discussed about effects of Moon's pratyantardasa in Moon's antardasa in Saturn mahadasa of Lord Sri Rama and also explored planetary combinations that have led to Lord Sri Rama breaking the bow and his wedding with Sita Devi.

Akkinapragada  $et\ al\ ^{[21]}$  has discussed the deadly planetary combination which led to Lord Sri Rama's encounter with Bhaargava Rama.

Akkinapragada *et al* <sup>[22]</sup> has discussed whether exalted Mars and Jupiter in Lord Sri Rama's planetary transit influenced King Dasaratha to coronate him as prince of Ayodhya.

Akkinapragada *et al* <sup>[23]</sup> has discussed about dreadful planetary placements paired with Sade Sati which forced Lord Sri Rama to go into exile.

Akkinapragada et al [24] has discussed about planetary

combinations that led to King Dasaratha's death based on Lord Sri Rama's astro transit chart.

Akkinapragada *et al* <sup>[25]</sup> has discussed about maraka planets that were responsible for King Dasaratha's death based on his four sons astro transit charts.

Akkinapragada *et al* <sup>[26]</sup> has discussed Bharatha's time of birth and lagna degrees, astro transit chart for his wedding and transfer of power from Lord Sri Rama.

Akkinapragada *et al* [27] has discussed Lakshmana's time of birth and reason for going into exile with Lord Sri Rama, based on his birth and astro transit charts.

Akkinapragada *et al* <sup>[28]</sup> has discussed planetary placements that made Shatrughna to remain close of comforts in Ayodhya instead of going into exile or sharing hermitage with Bharatha in Nandigrama.

Akkinapragada *et al* <sup>[29]</sup> has discussed about astro influence behind Bharatha's argument and agreement with Lord Sri Rama on Chitrakuta mountain.

In this research paper, we would like to explore astro transit planetary placements for Lord Sri Rama which made him meet noble and erudite sages like Sage Atri & Anasuya Devi, Sage Sharabhanga, Sage Suteekshana and further how Lord Sri Rama has won over daemon Viraadha in dandakaranya.

From Table-3 from Akkinapragada *et al* <sup>[24]</sup>, we know that King Dasaratha died after 8.54 days from Lord Sri Rama's exile day (which happens to be Vaisakha Shukla Paksha Panchami). From Table-1 from Akkinapragada *et al* <sup>[29]</sup>, we know that Bharatha met Lord Sri Rama on Chitrakuta mountain on 44<sup>th</sup> day from his exile from Ayodhya. Based on

these and further timeline mentioned in Valmiki Ramayana <sup>[30]</sup> Ayodhya Kanda, Sarga 116- Aranya Kanda Sarga 7, below sequence of events were put together to understand Lord Sri Rama's meeting with sages like Sage Atri, Sage Sharabhanga, Sage Suteekshana and encounter with daemon Viraadha in dandakaranya. Details are given in below Table-1.

**Table 1:** Outlines the sequence of events after Bharatha leaves Chitrakuta mountain and Lord Sri Rama meeting various sages and killing daemon Viraadha after abandoning his dwelling on Chitrakuta mountain

Ayodhya Kanda, Sarga 116	Rama notices anxiety among the sages who live in the vicinity	44 <sup>th</sup> day
Ayodhya Kanda, Sarga 117	Rama, after due reflection, decides to leave Chitrakuta mountain because of many handicaps. Setting out his journey from Chitrakuta mountain, he reaches the hermitage of Sage Atri and offers his salutation to him. Introducing his wife Anansuya as a great female ascetic to Rama, Atri urges Rama to send his concert Seetha to Anasuya. Anasuya receives Seetha, who greeted her and gives her instructions on the role and responsibilities of a devoted wife.	46 <sup>th</sup> day, we estimate that it could have taken about 2 days for Lord Sri Rama to decide to move away from Chitrakuta mountain, abandon his dwelling and to reach Sage Atri's hermitage.
Aranya Kanda, Sarga 1	Rama, Seetha, and Lakshmana enter the great forest called Dandaka Forest and adore the eminent sages, who are in penance and hermitages in that forest.	48 <sup>th</sup> or 49 <sup>th</sup> day
Aranya Kanda, Sarga 2	Viraadha the demon confronts Rama and other and tries to abduct Seetha, and then Rama. The killing of this Viraadha is the first act of Rama in eliminating negative forces in his empire to establish Rama Rajya. This killing is also a gift to Sage Sharabhanga, whom he meets later.	48 <sup>th</sup> or 49 <sup>th</sup> day
Aranya Kanda, Sarga 3	Rama and Lakshmana enter into a dialogue with Viraadha, the demon and shower arrows on him. Later, Viraadha, the demon carries Rama and Lakshmana away from Seetha.	48 <sup>th</sup> or 49 <sup>th</sup> day
Aranya Kanda, Sarga 4	Rama and Lakshmana come to know about the curse of Viraadha. Viraadha desires to die in the hands of Rama according to the amendment given by the cursing authority, and thus he will be killed and relieved of his curse by Rama, and his elimination of negative forces starts with the elimination of Viraadha. At the time of release from his curse, Viraadha advises Rama to go to Sage Sharabhanga, who can advise Rama properly.	48 <sup>th</sup> or 49 <sup>th</sup> day
Aranya Kanda, Sarga 5	Rama after killing demon Viraadha enters the hermitage of Sage Sharabhanga, as advised by the dying demon Viraadha in the previous episode. Sage Sharabhanga refuses the invitation of Indra to come to heaven, but awaits the arrival of Rama to see him with his own eyes. After seeing Rama, Seetha and Lakshmana, and also showing next course of their journey, that Sage enters the yogic fire and ascends to Brahma's abode.	48 <sup>th</sup> or 49 <sup>th</sup> day
Aranya Kanda, Sarga 6	After the heavenward journey of Sage Sharabhanga, Rama is approached by others sages and hermits. They inform him about the atrocities of demons around that place. They all ask Rama to eradicate the menace and Rama avows to do so, in order to keep up the tranquillity of those hermitages, and also to obliterate the menace of demons from earth.	48 <sup>th</sup> or 49 <sup>th</sup> day
Aranya Kanda, Sarga 7	Rama arrives at the hermitage of Sage Suteekshna, as directed by Sage Sharabhanga in the previous chapter and asks the sage to show a place to dwell. Suteekshna asks Rama to stay at his own hermitage, which has no other problems than the wild animals that come in herds and make blaring noises. Rama wishes to kill those animals that hamper the tranquillity of hermits living therein, but having observed the kindness of Suteekshna towards those wild animals, however disturbing they may be, Rama refrains to kill them, and would like to go to any other place than this. They spend that night there.	48 <sup>th</sup> or 49 <sup>th</sup> day

With reference to Table-1, we understand that it took 46 days to 49 days for Lord Sri Rama from start of his exile (Vaisakha Shukla Paksha Panchami) to meet sages like Sage Atri, Sage

Sharabhanga, Sage Suteekshana and encounter with daemon Viraadha in dandakaranya. Based on this, we now find possible transit planetary positions at these situations.

Table 2: Calculating transit planetary positions when Lord Sri Rama met Sage Atri and Anasuya Devi

Kanu	into Gemini.
Jupiter	Jupiter moves $30^{\circ}$ in 360 days. In 47.122 days, Jupiter moves $3.93^{\circ} + 5.138^{\circ}$ (Fig-2) and remains in Cancer at $9.068^{\circ}$ .
Saturn	Saturn moves 2' (minutes) each day. In 47.122 days, Saturn moves 1.57 <sup>0</sup> + 28.9277 <sup>0</sup> (Fig-2) and moves to Leo at 0.5 <sup>0</sup> .
Ketu	Ketu on an average moves 3' in a day. So in 47.122 days, Ketu moves by 2.3561 <sup>0</sup> . This means, Ketu remains in Capricorn or might
Ketu	move into Sagittarius.
Venus	Venus on an average moves 72' in a day. In 47.122 days, Venus moves 56.55 <sup>0</sup> + 8.7764 <sup>0</sup> (Fig-2) and moves to Aries at 5.33 <sup>0</sup> .

In Brihat Parasara Hora Sastra [31], Chapter 8 "Aspects of the Signs" on Page 105, the following slokas 1-3 are given (see Fig-5):

The meaning of slokas in Fig-5 is as follows: "Every movable sign aspects the 3 fixed signs leaving the fixed sign adjacent to it. Every fixed sign lends aspect to the 3 movable signs barring the adjacent movable sign. And a common sign aspects the other three common signs. The planet in a sign lends the same aspect as the sign (in which the planet is) does".




Fig 6: Brihat Parasara Hora Sastra [31], Chapter 8, Page 107, Slokas

The meaning of slokas in Fig-6 is as follows: "A planet in a movable sign aspects the other 3 fixed' signs leaving the fixed sign next to it. A planet in a fixed sign does not aspect the next movable sign but the remaining 3 movable signs' The one in a common sign throws aspect over the remaining 3 common signs. simultaneously a planet in the aspected sign is also subjected to the aspect concerned".

In Brihat Parasara Hora Sastra<sup>[31]</sup>, Chapter 34 "Yoga Karakas" on Page 350, the following slokas 27-28 are given (see Fig-7):

The meaning of slokas in Fig-7 is as follows: "Cancer

Ascendant: Venus and Mercury are malefics Mars, Jupiter and the Moon are auspicious Mars is capable of conferring a full-fledged yoga and giving auspicious effects. Saturn and the Sun are killers and give effects according to association. These are Cancer ascendants effects".

This along with the encounter day being a new moon day (Amavasya) is the reason why Lord Sri Rama had encountered daemon Viraadha during this transit period.

Ketu in Capricorn aspects Moon in Taurus and Saturn in Leo	Ketu is aspecting auspicious and exalted Moon in Taurus, because of which knowledge must have dominated the wavering mind of Lord Sri Rama.  Ketu is aspecting killer Saturn placed in Leo, because of which the knowledge of Lord Sri Rama helped him to dominate the hardships.

- Based on Table-6, we can infer that Lord Sri Rama had dominance of auspicious planets like Moon, Jupiter and Moon over malefic planet Venus and killer planets Saturn and Sun.
- 2. Because of the astro transit planetary placements, Lord Sri Rama had met erudite sages like Sage Atri and his wife Anasuya Devi, Sage Sharabhanga, Sage Suteekshna who all have given him wisdom advised on his duty to eradicate daemons in dandakaranya forest.
- Further, due to best placed and aspected planets in the astro transit chart, Lord Sri Rama won over daemon Viraadha in dandakaranya.
