A simple and structured numerology system for daily predictions using number repetition

Abstract

Most daily numerology methods are too simple. They use only one number (the Personal Date Number). This gives only nine options for everyone in the world. It makes the predictions general and repeated. This study made a new system that uses ten numbers every day. These numbers come from both birth date and current date. We used a simple method called frequency analysis. It checks which numbers are repeating more often. The system was tested on 60 people. More than 80% of them said the predictions were correct or useful. The method was put into an Excel program that makes instant reports. This shows numerology can be made more scientific and practical.

1. Introduction

Numerology is the study of how numbers affect people and their lives. It is often used to know personality, future, and daily guidance. But most daily methods are too simple. They use only one number each day, so the same prediction is repeated for millions of people. This makes the results too general. To solve this, we made a new model. Our model uses ten numbers together. It looks at both personal numbers (from birth) and universal numbers (from the calendar). This makes the daily prediction more personal and realistic.

2. Materials and Methods

2.1 System design

We used 10 main numbers every day:

- 4 personal numbers: Year, Month, Date, Weekday (from date of birth).
- 4 universal numbers: Year, Month, Date, Weekday (from the current date).
- Life path number.
- Destiny number.

2.2 Frequency method

We used a method called frequency analysis. It checks how many times each number (0–9) appears. Each life area (Finance, Health, Relationship, Work, Social) was linked with three special numbers. Depending on how many times these numbers appeared, a ready statement was chosen. This way each person got different results every day. In total, there were 216 possible statements for each life area.

2.3 Excel program

An Excel program was made for this. The user puts only two things: Date of Birth and Prediction Date. The program then:

- Finds all 10 numbers.
- Counts how many times each number comes.
- Chooses the right statements.
- Makes a full report with 5 parts (Finance, Health, Relationship, Work, Social).

2.4 Testing

We tested this with 60 people. They were between 16 and 80 years old. We sent daily predictions to them on WhatsApp. They shared their feedback the same day. This helped us see how useful and accurate the system was.

3. Results

The test gave very good results:

- 82% people said the predictions were accurate or useful.
- 10% said they were neutral.
- 8% said they did not match.

When we checked each life area:

Finance: 3.3 out of 4
Work: 3.3 out of 4
Health: 3.2 out of 4
Social: 3.2 out of 4
Relationship: 3.0 out of 4

The real-time testing made it strong because people compared their day with the prediction on the same day.

5. Conclusion

The study shows that numerology can be made more scientific and personal. By using 10 numbers, frequency check, and an Excel tool, daily predictions became more accurate. Most people felt the results were true for them. This system can be useful for daily life guidance, counseling, and self-growth.
